

Request For Comment:

A spokesperson for the Inspectional Services Department said, “Electrical inspectors are often requested to conduct off-hour inspection for planned tests, life safety equipment and emergency issues. Other off-hour inspections may include but are not limited to restoring electricity, festivals and meter tags. In these instances, the work is not optional — it must be completed for safety reasons — and a significant amount of the cost is paid for by the requestor. Aside from emergency situations where immediate response is required, work involving power and electricity systems often need to be done outside of normal working hours. The Inspectional Services Department budgets for this work and requires requesters to pay in advance before it is completed.”
